**Club dues are way past due now; please pay them as soon as possible!**



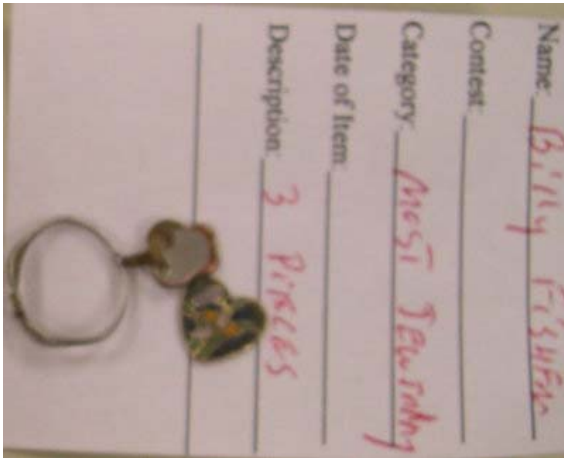


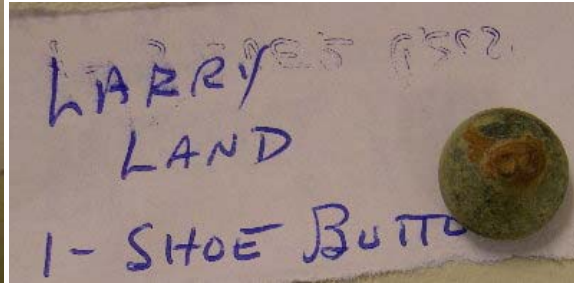
